What we intend to do is not without significant cost. A healthy animal to receive preadoption care is \$200. Should the animal need injury care it can be hundreds of dollars. It can cost \$100 or more to get initial items such as a collar, leash, bed, blanket and food. Simply put to ready an animal for adoption could cost us upwards of \$500 or more.

There are many people and families who would be able to take care of a new family member, but the initial costs can be great and be a barrier to many animals finding new homes. Our goal is to reduce the costs of adoption and furthermore to mitigate the number of animal surrenders.

We believe that the current economic climate is the number one reason for animal surrender in our county. It is for that reason that we would like to set up a program that provides food and possibly cat litter for people who are struggling. This is just one of the ways we strive to help the community.

We are always trying to mitigate problems at the source instead of “putting out fires”. As stated previously it can be costly. We look forward to Partnering with Local and National business to help the smallest in our community.
